ABOUT OUR DISTRICT

Extending across 29 square miles of Kootenai County, Coeur d'Alene Public Schools is an education leader, promoting opportunities for innovation in learning and inspiring excellence in everyone. District 271 serves the cities of Coeur d'Alene, Hayden, Hayden Lake, Dalton Gardens and Fernan Village, as well as adjacent unincorporated areas.

With over 10,000 students, it's the sixth largest school district in Idaho. The District has a workforce of 1,450 and a general fund budget of \$80 million. Voters have approved the last 19 supplemental school levies placed on the ballot. The Board of Trustees includes five members elected to four-year terms.

The School District offers comprehensive instructional programs from preschool through high school, designed to provide students with a balance of knowledge, skills and dispositions that will support their success through their school journey and in future endeavors such as college, careers, military service, family, volunteer work and community involvement. We have 19 schools: a developmental preschool, 11 elementary schools, three middle schools, two traditional high schools, an alternative high school, and our new K-12 online school.

The District has a graduation rate of 91.5%, with 79% of graduates moving on to higher education immediately after graduation. Additionally, 73% of students take advanced coursework, and 20% of secondary students pursue college or professional-technical credits in high school.

ABOUT OUR COMMUNITY

Against the backdrop of mountains and sprawling lakes in North Idaho, Coeur d'Alene is paradise for outdoor recreation. Located on the north shore of Lake Coeur d'Alene, the city is at the center of Kootenai County, population 175,000, and just 35 miles east of Spokane, Washington, home to Gonzaga University and the region's international airport.

Coeur d'Alene's economy is built on tourism and recreation, health care, technology, construction and manufacturing. The Coeur d'Alene Resort is considered one of the top resorts in the West. The community enjoys four distinct seasons with clean air and no humidity. Coeur d'Alene is home to North Idaho College and branch campuses of the University of Idaho and Lewis-Clark State College, as well as the Human Rights Education Institute.
