2nd Grade - They are making their first relief, oil pastels as a resist then watercolors and assembling. The name of this concept is Winter Mugs.

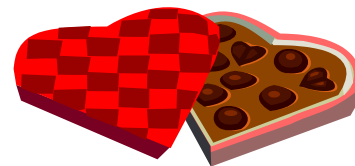
1st Grade - They are painting with sponges and then cutting their paper to create a penguin in the snow. Collage at it's best!
