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PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE...

Welcome back to Lake City High School. We have truly missed our students and look forward to the day when things return to normal!! We begin this school year with approximately 1670 in our student body. 200 of our Timberwolves are taking advantage of our new eschool. We have approximately 130 staff members here at Lake City High School. We started this school year in the orange stage. This stage requires us to deliver in person instruction 2 days per week and remote learning 3 days per week. Please be advised that students are responsible for all assignments and activities for every class and that, unlike last spring, every assignment is graded. Remember ALL High School grades count and will be posted to the official transcript.

We are very happy to welcome back our respectful, kind and united student body. We covered all of the procedures, rules and expectations for our students in their A2 classes on their 1st day back to school. If you have any question please do not hesitate to ask. We also made it a point to inform students about the negative effects of student-to-student harassment and bullying and the harmful effects of inappropriate social media use. I want to complement our students for their kindness and compassion.

Communicating with parents is a very high priority at our school. our Parent Advisory Committee (PAC) meets the third Tuesday of every month 5:30-6:30pm in the LCHS library. Thanks to the hard work of our PAC we have a growing and successful PTSA. You can join PTSA-PAC anytime. Check in the office for more information. The agenda includes reports from a counselor, the principal and student council as well as various teachers and advisors. We also listen to parent thoughts, comments and concerns. Our next meeting is in the library on Oct. 20th. Please join us!

Communication about your student's grades is vital. You will be prompted to check family access for academic progress every six weeks and at semester. If you have concerns about your student's academic progress, we would encourage you to contact his/her teacher, our counseling office or call the main office and let us assist you.

In closing, we would like to invite all parents to our Parent conference night on the evening of Thursday, November 12th from 4:00-7:00pm. We provide this after-school format in hope that all of our parents will be available to attend meetings with teachers after the six-week grading period. We are asking parents to print your students' grades and schedule from skyward Family Access then attend the parent conference night. This is an open invitation night, no appointments with teachers are necessary. We look forward to having you here November 12th. It is our strong view that early intervention is the very best option for dealing with students who are having academic difficulties. Make sure that you are following their academic progress and allow us to assist you if you have any concerns.

TRANSCRIPTS

CURRENT students can obtain a Transcript Release form from Mrs. Ventresco in the Counseling Office. FORMER students should see the Registrar, Mrs. Patterson for their transcripts. There is a \$3.00 charge per transcript.

NOTE:

Transcripts cannot be released if a student has fines owing. Please see the bookkeeper as soon as possible to clean accounts so transcripts can be released. If you have any classroom textbooks that need to be returned, please return them to the bookkeeper (Mrs. Woodall).

FROM THE NURSE

HELLO LCHS PARENTS!

IN THIS TIME OF THE YEAR WHERE STUDENTS ARE STAYING HOME SICK FOR VARIOUS REASONS WHEN YOU CALL THE SCHOOL TO TELL US YOUR CHILD IS SICK CAN YOU PLEASE GIVE AN EXPLANATION. ACROSS THE DISTRICT WE ARE TRACKING COVID SYMPTOMS AS WELL AS OTHER SYMPTOMS. SO PLEASE LET US KNOW IF YOUR CHILD HAS COVID LIKE SYMPTOMS SUCH AS A FEVER, SORE THROAT, NEW UNCONTROLLED COUGH, DIARRHEA, VOMITING, ABDOMINAL PAIN, OR SEVERE HEADACHE. THIS CAN BE LEFT IN THE PHONE MESSAGE OR WRITTEN IN ON SKYWARD.

WE WOULD LIKE TO SHARE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ABOUT A NEW REQUIREMENT FOR THE 12TH-GRADE MENINGOCOCCAL BOOSTER SHOT.

YOUR 12TH-GRADE STUDENT MAY NEED A MENINGOCOCCAL VACCINATION. THIS VACCINATION IS CRITICAL TO PROTECTING YOUR CHILD'S HEALTH AS TEENS AND YOUNG ADULTS ARE AT INCREASED RISK FOR MENINGOCOCCAL DISEASE. MENINGOCOCCAL DISEASE CAN BE DIFFICULT TO DIAGNOSE BECAUSE THE SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS ARE OFTEN SIMILAR TO THOSE OF OTHER ILLNESSES, BUT THE DISEASE HAS LIFE-ALTERING CONSEQUENCES INCLUDING DEATH IN A FEW SHORT HOURS. PLEASE CONTACT YOUR CHILD'S PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT FOR VACCINATION. IF YOUR CHILD DOES NOT HAVE A PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER, HERITAGE HEALTH WILL BE OFFERING VACCINATIONS AT YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL.
