Vaccinations While You Shop

Did you know that if you are shopping at a superstore retailer, you may be able to get your child's vaccinations at the walk-up **Pharmacy Counter** with no appointment! Ages and availability varies by store — see the pharmacist for details.

A Full Set of School Vaccinations Includes:

- (5) Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis (DTaP)
- (2) Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR)
- (4) Polio
- (3) Hepatitis B
- (2) Varicella (Chickenpox)
- (2) Hepatitis A
- (1) Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap) – *after 6th Grade*
- (1) Meningococcal – *after 6th Grade*
