



## Dual Credit Enrollment Procedures

### DUAL Credit Eligibility:

3.0 or higher cumulative GPA

16+ Years Old

A minimum of ½ high school credits completed or in progress

### Steps to Becoming a DUAL Credit Student

1. Apply to your intended Course Provider (NIC, University of Idaho, LCSC etc.)
2. Schedule your placement assessments as needed
3. Meet with the college and career coordinator to select your intended courses based on your placement, high school graduation requirements and post-secondary plans
4. Turn in a copy of your schedule to the College and Career Center
