Seth Deniston - District Print Shop Closing:

After almost 10 years, the decision was made to close the District print shop at Venture High School at the close of this school year. Much of the equipment was coming to its end of life, and the replacement cost is cost-prohibitive. Additionally, this will allow **Lena Cooley** to offer additional CTE courses for KTEC and Venture. We are working on a request for Print Shop Services from local companies, which will come to the Board for approval later this spring.

Kate Keinert - Silverwood Reading To Ride (R2R) Companion Tickets:

You may recall last year when CDA SD and Silverwood partnered to offer "eligible" students a companion ticket to their Read to Ride challenge.

GREAT NEWS! Silverwood is able to offer these companion tickets again this year!

We all know so many of our students track and invest in their reading to score a free ticket to Silverwood, only to have it go unused when they can't find an adult who can afford to take them. Silverwood understands this barrier and is offering *1 companion ticket per eligible student*. The list will be kept at the ticketing office (essentially will-call). All the student needs to share at the ticket office is their name. This is AWESOME because we don't have to add an adult name to these companion tickets! That means whoever ends up able to take the student can get in for free (which removes the second barrier of advanced planning and committing a specific person).

"Eligible" students are those who would typically qualify for free/reduced lunch prices, are experiencing homelessness, living in foster care, receive food packs over the weekends, etc. Teachers and counselors will coordinate to review completed R2R forms and contact families of students who will benefit. Schools have until June 10th to submit names. **Kate Keinert** (CDA SD) and **Stephanie Sampson** (Silverwood) are coordinating to ensure a smooth process.
