Mike Nelson - Engagement Surveys Concluding:

Over the past ten weeks, our District has reached out to parents, staff, and students to complete statewide surveys measuring their satisfaction with our schools and District. The surveys are mandated by the Idaho accountability framework, and aggregate results are posted annually for every Idaho school and district on the statewide report card at www.idahoschools.org.

Unfortunately, the student engagement surveys were inaccessible statewide on Thursday and Friday of this week, and many of our schools were unable to finalize their work to meet state benchmarks. We have reached out to the State Department of Education and Cognia (survey provider) to inquire whether the surveys would be reopened or whether the state would provide flexibility on the 95% goal.

As the surveys officially closed on Friday, April 8th, we wanted to provide you with our response rates:

- Parent survey 18.20% with a goal of 20%
- Staff survey 98.57% with a goal of 90%
- Student survey 77.11% with a goal of 95%

We look forward to sharing our District results with comparisons to previous years in the coming weeks.
