Mike Nelson - SAT Grade Levels Adjusted For 2022-2023:

A recent change by the Idaho State Board of Education will adjust the grade level of the high school ISAT starting in the 2022-2023 school year. The English language arts, mathematics, and science assessments will now all be taken in grade 11, not grade 10 as has been the practice. As you may know, the exam currently does measure 11/12th grade standards but has been administered at grade 10 for the past decade, so these results should be more reliable.

This does, also provide extra consideration to the date of the SAT school-day as it is temporarily scheduled in the middle of the same ISAT window on the approved calendar for 2022-2023. We have not signed a contract for the PSAT/SAT for the coming school and will look for guidance from you and high school administrators to discuss this assessment as a means to meet the local graduation requirement.

Mike Nelson - SAT School-Day Spring Results FY2022:

We have received our results for the 88% of Juniors who took the SAT Schoolday in April. Results are also posted on our District website on the data dashboard (www.cdaschools.org > About Us > Data Dashboard) and at our SAT page at www.cdaschools.org > Departments > Assessments > SAT.

2022-23 Actual Enrollment as of 05/26/22:

The attached reports show current enrollment in Skyward for the **2022-23 school year** as of 5/26/22. The report also notes building capacity in order to see where needs may be.
