In November/December we conducted two ThoughtExchanges asking for feedback on the two levies the Board voted to place on the March ballot.

We had over 1,000 participants between the two exchanges, with 800 thoughts shared and over 22,000 ratings of the thoughts others had shared.

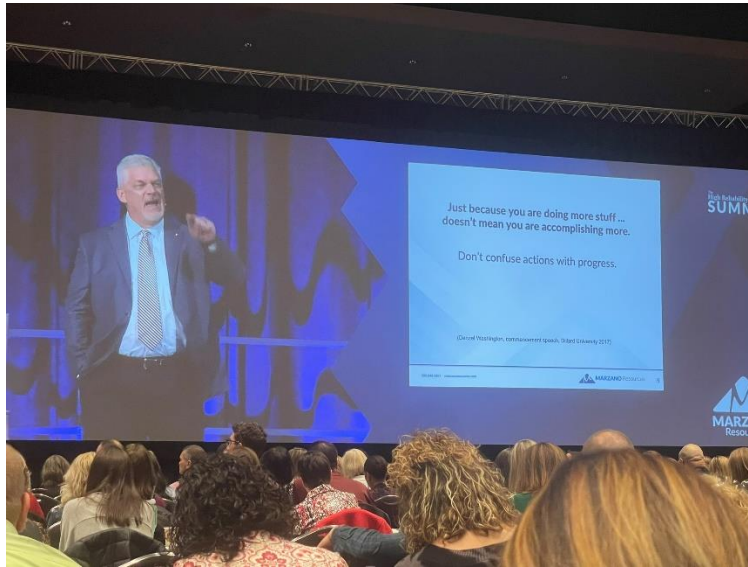

Mike Nelson - Small Team Visits High-Reliability Schools Summit:

District Office Administrators **Trent Derrick**, **Patty Morrison**, **Mike Nelson**, and **Heather Somers** were in San Antonio this week at the annual High-reliability Schools (HRS) Summit with approximately 1500 teachers and administrators. The Summit provided multiple keynote and breakout sessions around the HRS framework:

- Safe, Supportive, and Collaborative Culture
- Effective Teaching in Every Classroom
- Guaranteed and Viable Curriculum
- Standards-Referenced Reporting
- Competency-Based Education

We were inspired by founders **Robert J. Marzano** and **Phil Warrick** (pictured) who highlighted the purpose of the framework and spent many hours identifying the best way to incorporate these validations beginning next school year at level 1 - coinciding with our emphasis on professional learning communities (PLCs). Our leaders have already begun orienting building and District leaders to the framework and will continue to take on our first indicators for success in the coming months.
