### **Mike Nelson - Idaho Reading Indicator Fall Results:**


The fall Idaho Reading Indicator was provided to students in grades KG-03 between the first day of classes and October 9<sup>th</sup>. Our District also uses the same assessment, IStation, to progress monitor reading growth in grades 04-05. A summary of results by building are presented below, including:

- The percentage of students at each building whose students are currently reading at grade level, or in "tier 1;" compared to students in the previous school year; and
- A distribution of students by grade level currently with their reading tier ("1" at grade level, "2" approaching grade level, "3" well below grade level)






### 2020-21 DISTRICT ENROLLMENT




### 2020-21 HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT
