

11/13/2020 - Weekly Board Notes

Seth Deniston - Technology - Fiber Wide Area Network (WAN) RFP:

We have been working on an RFP that will go out next week for our Fiber Wide Area Network (WAN) contract, which was initially signed in 2011 with Fatbeam, and will expire June 30, 2021. Our WAN connects all of our buildings back to maintenance, where we house many of our District servers such as Skyward, Destiny library software, door access control, video surveillance, and many more. Our WAN also allows us to distribute Internet access to all buildings from maintenance.

The RFP will be posted Wednesday, and RFPs will be accepted until December 18th. We are requesting contract terms of 5 or 10 years, with provisions to allow for future bandwidth growth, following E-Rate rules and regulations. Currently, 60% of this contract is reimbursement through the federal E-Rate program, with the other 40% being reimbursed through the state Education Opportunity Resource Committee (EORC) broadband program.

Mike Nelson - i-Ready Mathematics Diagnostic Results:

Students in grades KG-08 took the i-Ready mathematics diagnostic during our fall assessment window and the results are provided by building. Results are shown in three tiers:

- Tier 1 [shown in green]- At/near grade level
- Tier 2 [shown in yellow] - Approaching/below grade level
- Tier 3 [shown in red] - Well below grade level

A comparison of results to the previous school year show 2% more students in the Tier 3 category.

It is also important to notice that some students in our high schools are provided the i-Ready diagnostic as an additional indicator of holes in learning, but that these students will also be provided Illuminate Fastbridge as our diagnostic and progress monitoring tool.
