Seth Deniston - Governor Little Tik Tok Ban:

On Thursday, December 15th, <u>Gov. Little banned TikTok</u> from any state devices or networks. While this does not specifically apply to schools, we ensured that we are blocking this app as well. It was already blocked for student accounts and devices, and we have extended that to staff accounts and devices as well. We also ensured that the app is not able to be installed on District devices.

Mike Nelson - Cohort Graduation Rates Received:

The Idaho State Department of Education has released our high school "on time" graduation rates for the Class of 2022. As a District, we maintained a 90% rate over the past two years with nominal changes at each of our high schools. We have also provided our rates disaggregated by federal race and have begun to discuss how to best support all students based on the data provided.

As a reminder, each state in our country uses a four-year adjusted cohort graduation rate to identify the number of students who graduate in four years with a regular high school diploma - up to the start of the next school year after the expected graduation date to be included.
