

12/18/2020 - Weekly Board Notes

Seth Deniston - Internet Access For Families:

So far this school year, 191 families (representing 322 students) have completed our request for assistance with Internet access. Applications have continued to come in as recent as this week. We've checked out about 120 hotspots so far, and have more on available for checkout if needed. Several schools have submitted applications and picked up hotspots for delivery as they discover families in need.

We've also been working with local providers Zply, Intermax and Spectrum to provide internet directly to families, funded through CARES act funds. So far close to 30 families have been identified for service, although we're in the final stages of completing this.

Mike Nelson - PSAT Results Posted:

291 Sophomores and Juniors opted into the PSAT/NMSQT on a Saturday or Wednesday blended learning day this fall at our high schools. Results by building for this assessment and compared to other students who took the exam in previous years are available below. Results for Venture High School are not reportable due to the small sample size.

Please note that there is limited comparability of the results as our sample size was about 1/3 of normal. However, for the results of this assessment, there was noticed growth in overall mean scores and the percentage of students meeting the College Board's readiness benchmarks. Additionally, the College Board has opened an additional PSAT/NMSQT test day in late January 2021 and several District students are enrolled. Therefore, these results will be updated after receipt approximately 6 weeks later.

Katie Graupman - Point Of Clarification:

According to the November 2018 minutes, the Board discussed the change in course designation from ALP to Honors. After that meeting, the decision was made to proceed with changing course titles from ALP to honors beginning the 2019-2020 school year.

These changes were made in practice; however, there was still some cleanup to do in policies. Policy 2700-P1-6 still reflected the ALP wording, rather than the honors designation. That was cleaned up and changed this week in Board Policy to reflect the correct wording.

Mike Nelson - Fall SAT Results Posted:

Our current Seniors did not have the opportunity to take the PSAT as scheduled last spring. Instead, the state offered the exam this fall on a Tuesday in October. 568 current 12th graders (~75% participation) took the assessment in part to meet the statewide college entrance exam graduation requirement. A summary of results is provided for this singular administration and a comparison with other schooldays exams usually provided in the spring.

Our current Juniors are scheduled to take the SAT in the spring and monthly exams are available for any of the students who have not yet met that milestone.

Mike Nelson - FastBridge Norms By Building And Grade Level:

In follow-up from the December meeting of the Board, I reached out to Illuminate FastBridge regarding comparability data in Idaho. Unfortunately, they refused to share scores from other districts, and the other Idaho system that I know uses FastBridge was not comfortable sharing results.

In the goal to provide you data closer to what you are looking for, I have provided a comparison of our schools and the associated norms for both our school District and nation. The document is organized by building and assessment (Canfield aMath [HS math] and Canfield aReading...) and the bands are color-coded with the scale at the bottom of each page. I'm glad to provide you additional data at your request.

Additionally, our winter assessment window opens after the coming break, and I look forward to providing you growth results by building in early February.
