Mike Nelson - SAT Schoolday Held Wednesday:

On Wednesday, 81% of the District's Juniors and a handful of Seniors took the SAT schoolday as part of our District's college and career preparedness pathway and in order to meet the state's college entrance exam graduation requirement. In discussions with staff and students, the exams were administered professionally and without major issue at Coeur d'Alene, Lake City, and Venture High Schools. We expect to have results in 3-4 weeks and expect to present them, along with the Saturday ACT/SAT administrations, publicly at the June meeting of the Board.

Also, in order to continuously improve, feedback surveys have been provided to staff and students about the exam and its part in our college and career preparedness activities.

Mike Nelson - Remote ISAT Begins At eSchool:

In pandemic schooling, we've seen remarkable accommodations from the College Board and State Department of Education regarding assessment administration. An example of this is our first-ever remote ISATs which started at eSchool this week. In these administrations, parents/guardians sign an agreement allowing students to take their English language arts, mathematics, and science assessments at home with a Webcam and microphone. The teacher or test administrator is able to see their work, answer questions, and support their learning. While we did have some technical challenges, mostly from students using personal devices (rather than District Chromebooks) and Internet lagging, most students were able to complete their first exams in one sitting.
