Following **Mr. Paulson's** public comment at the September 12th Board Meeting regarding finger scanning without consent, we reviewed our current records and did find that several students were finger scanned throughout the District without consent. In discussion, we found that our office and nutrition services staff were unaware of this opt-out checkbox and did not run the reports to properly identify students who have been excluded.

Students who did consent to a finger scan, although their parent/guardian did not, will be issued a barcoded card for lunch purchases. All previous scans have been removed from our software and we will begin notifying parents and guardians personally starting on Friday.
