








# HIGH SCHOOL SEMESTER 1 GRADE DISTRIBUTIONS








### **ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSE ENROLLMENT BY RACE & PROGRAM**










# PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS ACHIEVING 4+ ON AP EXAMS










#### **IDLA STUDENT USE BY BUILDING**








#### **IDLA USE BY SEMESTER**




Percentage of Semester; IDLA Courses Since 2016





# SEATS IN DUAL CREDIT CLASSES (ON & OFF CAMPUS)




Number of Seats Taken in Dual Credit Classes Off/On Campus




# MOST POPULAR DUAL CREDIT COURSES - SY2020






## DUAL CREDIT PROVIDERS AND COURSE LOCATION







#### **VENTURE HIGH SCHOOL ENROLLMENT** IN-DISTRICT SENDING SCHOOLS (≥2016)




#### VENTURE ENROLLMENT OUT-OF-DISTRICT SENDING DISTRICTS (≥2016)






