

Number of AP Students/Examinations




# ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSE ENROLLMENT BY RACE & PROGRAM





Including only those exams in which both schools had 20 or more total exams taken in the subject area between 2015-2019.




# PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS ACHIEVING 4+ ON **AP EXAMS**



Coeur d'Alene High School Percentage of AP Exams Earning 4/5




Lake City High School Percentage of AP Exams Earning 4/5
