3	Alex White	Ramsey Magnet School of Science Championship Word: meteor (\medear\) [8 rounds] Definition: any of the small particles of matter in the solar system that are directly observable only by their incandescence from frictional heating on entry into the atmosphere	
4	Cyrus Stockert	Bryan Elementary School Championship Word: ferret (\'ferat\) [6 rounds] Definition: a domesticated usually albino, brownish, or silver-gray animal (mustela putorius furo) that is descended from the European polecat	
5	Owen Pulsipher	Sorensen Magnet School of the Arts and Humanities Championship Word: ricochet (\rika,SHā\) [10 rounds] Definition: cause to rebound off a surface	
6	Lauren Hinchliff	Canfield Middle School Championship Word: unstinting (\ən'stin(t)iNG\) [1 round] Definition: given or giving without restraint; unsparing	
7	Samuel Granier	Canfield Middle School Championship Word: convection (\kan'vekSH(a)n\) [5 rounds] Definition: the movement caused within a fluid by the tendency of hotter and therefore less dense material to rise, and colder, denser material to sink under the influence of gravity, which consequently results in transfer of heat	
8	Alexander Eller	Canfield Middle School Championship Word: razorbill (\ rāzər,bil\) [3 rounds] Definition: a black-and-white auk (seabird) with a deep bill that is said to resemble a straight razor, found in the North Atlantic and Baltic Sea	The second secon
