## PARENT ENGAGEMENT SURVEY

Our annual parent engagement survey, developed by Cognia, has been provided to parents/guardians districtwide for the past three years. A percentage of agreement (choose of "agree" or "strongly agree") is shown below. The cells are shaded based on proximity of agreement with cells that are more red reflecting less agreement and cells shaded more in green indicating a higher percentage.

## STUDENT ENGAGEMENT SURVEY

Our annual staff engagement survey, developed by Cognia, has been provided to students in grades 03-12 for the past five years. However, the survey was redesigned in the 2019-2020 school year, yielding two years of comparative data. The chart below provides the percentage of students who answered that they were committed behaviorally, emotionally, and cognitively to their work and life in our schools. As of today, we have not received the student data file from which we could disaggregate eSchool student responses from their home schools.

The cells are shaded based on proximity of agreement with cells that are more red reflecting less agreement and cells shaded more in green indicating a higher percentage.
