

Resolution of the Board of Education of Coeur d'Alene School District #271

Exploration of The NExA School Site and Expectations for School Facilities

WHEREAS, the Coeur d'Alene School District is responsible for providing suitable facilities for schools; and

WHEREAS, research demonstrates that students who take pride in their learning facilities perform higher on most measures of student performance; and

WHEREAS, the patrons of the Coeur d'Alene School District have historically demonstrated support for quality school facilities for students; and

WHEREAS, the current facilities of the Northwest Expeditionary Academy are currently substandard compared to other schools across the district;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the board directs the superintendent to present information and a recommendation to the board considering the immediate needs of the current NExA facilities, including the costs to improve the conditions of the school and eventually bring the facility up to a standard that meets or exceeds the expectation for school facilities across the district. The superintendent shall ensure that the following conditions are met:

That the work shall include input and feedback from the NExA staff and community; and

That an ongoing discussion will continue regarding the possible long-term solutions for the NExA school and site; and

That continued engagement of the LRPC for input and feedback on the long-term vision of the district facility plan;

That the information and recommendations shall be presented to the board during the first board meeting in April 2019.
