

**SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 271 -- RESOLUTION 20-21-002**  
**(19-20-002)**

**EXTENSION OF SOFT CLOSURE**

This Resolution is made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2020, by the Coeur d'Alene School District #271, whose address is 1400 Northwood Center Court, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho 83814 (the "District"), to extend the soft closure of District schools in compliance with the directions of the Idaho State Board of Education:

**RECITALS:**

WHEREAS, the District is a validly organized and existing school district authorized under Title 33, Chapter 3 of the Idaho Code;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has the power to close District schools in the case of an emergency;

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2020, State Board of Education directed all school districts in the State of Idaho to implement school closures through the end of the 2019-2020 academic school year due to the COVID-19 emergency, during which time students would not be allowed in school buildings but districts would continue to provide education and essential services to the best of their abilities

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2020, in compliance with the direction of the State Board, the Superintendent announced the extension of the soft closure through the end of the 2019-2020 school year and the Board desires to ratify the same as more specifically set forth herein.


NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved as follows:

1. The Board hereby ratifies and adopts the decision of the Superintendent to close all District schools through the end of the 2019-2020 academic school year, as implemented and consistent with the directive of the State Board of Education, unless said closure is earlier lifted by the appropriate authorities or until local and state social distancing orders have been lifted and re-entry criteria established by the state board have been met.
2. The Board further directs the Superintendent to continue to provide remote educational opportunities, free breakfast and lunch opportunities, and childcare services to emergency responders, to the best ability of the District and in a manner deemed appropriate by the Superintendent and consistent with all directives of the State Board of Education, and all state and local authorities and guidelines.

This Resolution shall remain in effect for so long as the foregoing proclamations, orders, and acts remain in effect, including any extensions thereto.
