What does it mean, how are schools operating?

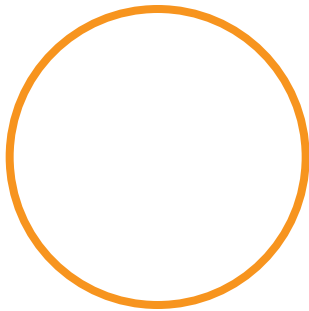

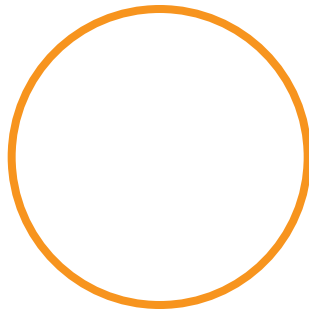
Continue to follow the practices below to keep the dial moving back toward a lower risk level and prevent it from escalating.

High-risk individuals should operate under stricter instructions because they are more likely to suffer severe illness from COVID-19.

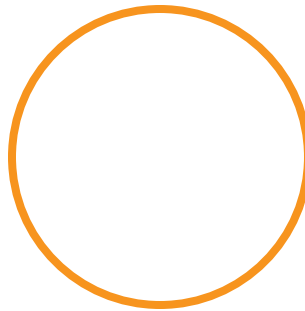

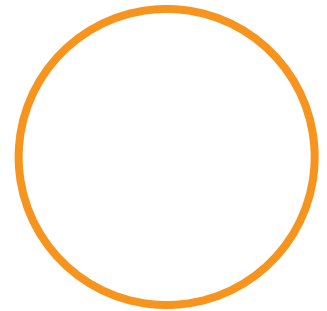
Blended Learning Students

remotely 3 days



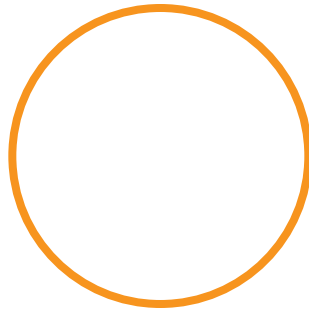
In-Person Schedule Last

(Mon-Tue), L-Z (Thu-Fri)



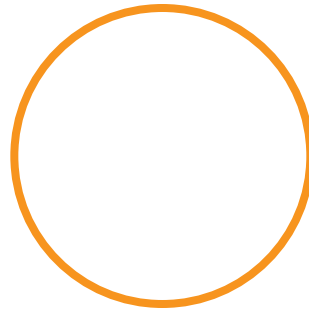
Social Distancing Students

stay in cohort groups



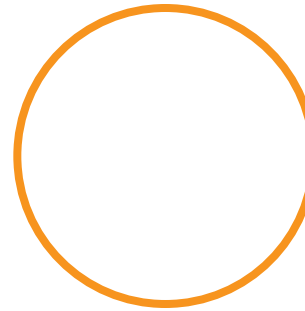
Visitor Restrictions

external group events



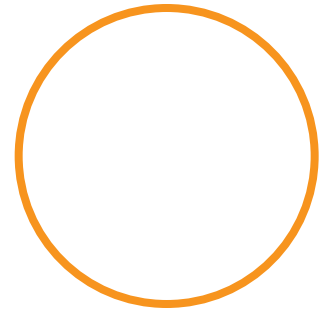
Masks Required Students

shields at school, on bus



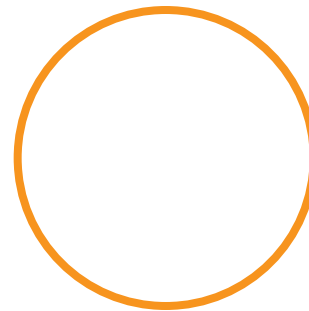
Stay Home If Sick

stays home, self-isolates



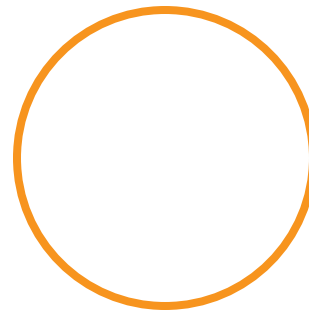
Illness Screening

before coming to school



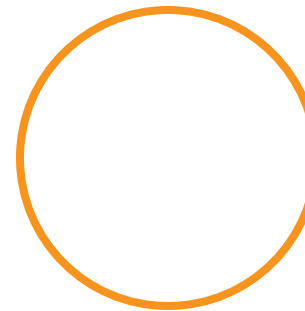
Deep Cleaning

cleaning every Wednesday



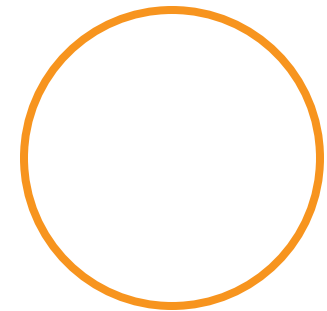
Athletics
