

RIGHT TO RECEIVE TEACHER INFORMATION

Dear Parent:

Federal law requires that each school district receiving Title I funds notify the parents of each student attending a Title I school that information regarding the professional qualifications of their child's classroom teacher(s) may be requested.

As a parent of a student attending a Title I school, you have the right to know:

- Is my child's teacher certified to teach the grades and subject areas assigned?
- Is my child's teacher teaching with a provisional license, meaning the state has waived the teaching requirements?
- What is the college major of my child's teacher?
- What degree or degrees does the teacher hold?
- If there are instructional aides working with my child, what are their qualifications?
- If my child is or will be taught more than 4 or more consecutive weeks this year by a teacher who is not highly qualified, will I be notified in a timely manner?

To request the state qualifications for your child's teacher or instructional aide, please contact the office of your school. In addition, if you would like more information about your child's school, please feel free to contact the school office for more information.
