Important Information

Kindergarten

Required Items:

ON-LINE VERIFICATION FOR THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR

On-line verification for the 2020-2021 school year will be available to parents starting on Monday, July 14th through Friday, August 21st. Any student who attended ANY Coeur d'Alene School District school in 2020-2021 can verify on-line. This includes returning to the same school, moving to a new school or moving on to a middle or high school. This verification process lets us know that your child will be returning to Atlas.

Registration for new students will be on Thursday, August 20th from 9:00 a.m.—6:00 p.m.

No child will be actively enrolled until we have the following information: proof of residency, current immunization records and a state certified birth certificate.
