The Coeur d'Alene School District strives to provide all students with a range of experiences to meet local and state technology standards. These standards include electronic communication, so it is important for students to become proficient with this tool. In order to meet these standards and give our students hands-on experience with email, the district is providing grade 4-12 students with a Google email and Drive account.

The web-based Gmail account will allow students to submit assignments electronically or easily collaborate with other students on topics being studied. All communication will pass through a number of filters provided by Gaggle.net, so that any messages with offensive language, questionable domains, banned file types, or pornographic images will be automatically blocked and rerouted for review.

In addition to email, Gmail provides students with access to Drive, which is an online file storage system. Files can be uploaded and accessed from anywhere, so students can work on documents or projects at home without needing a USB drive.

Students are automatically provided a Google account and no action is necessary unless you do not wish to have your child have an account.
