As a member of the Ramsey Magnet School of Science community, students are expected to wear clothes that meet uniform guidelines while attending school. The daily expectation is 100% compliance. If a student chooses to dress inappropriately, parents will be contacted. The student will change into appropriate clothes and be reminded about the uniform guidelines. Additional violations will be subject to disciplinary action.

Uniform Tops:

Uniform shirts consist of a plain, solid-colored, long or short sleeved shirt or sweatshirt with the Ramsey logo on the left upper chest corner. Brand names and logos must not be visible. Shirts should be constructed so the tops of the shoulders are covered with no less than a 2 ½ inch strap (e.g. no halter tops, strapless tops, spaghetti straps, or bare shoulder tops of any type will be allowed). Students can choose any color they desire. The uniform guidelines do not prohibit students from wearing coats, jackets, sweaters, or other appropriate outer garments as needed for weather conditions. If a student desires to wear an outer garment (sweater, vest, or sweatshirt) in the building, it must have a visible logo.

Special Chorus:

Special Chorus will have shirts for performance events. To demonstrate the concepts of community, pride, and respect, students must be dressed in their Special Chorus uniform to participate in performance events.

Uniform Bottoms:

Girls and Boys: All pants must be clean, free from holes, and in good condition. No pajama pants or slippers allowed. All shorts and skirts must be no shorter than mid-thigh from the bottom of the knee.
