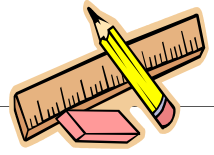




Ramsey Magnet School of Science Class Supply Lists 2016-2017

UNIFORM POLICY

As a member of the Ramsey Magnet School of Science community, students are expected to wear clothes that meet uniform guidelines while attending school. The daily expectation is 100% compliance.

Uniform Tops:

Uniform shirts consist of a plain, solid-colored, long or short sleeved shirt or sweatshirt with the Ramsey logo on the left upper chest corner. Brand names and logos must not be visible. Shirts should be constructed so the tops of the shoulders are covered with no less than a 2 1/2 inch strap (e.g. no halter tops, strapless tops, spaghetti straps, or bare shoulder tops of any type will be allowed). Students can choose any color they desire. The uniform guidelines do not prohibit students from wearing coats, jackets, sweaters, or other appropriate outer garments as needed for weather conditions. If a student desires to wear an outer garment (sweater, vest, or sweatshirt) in the building, it must have a visible logo.

Uniform Bottoms:

Girls and Boys: All pants must be clean, free from holes, and in good condition. No pajama pants or slippers allowed. All shorts and skirts must be no shorter than mid-thigh from the bottom of the knee.

ON-LINE REGISTRATION FOR THE 2016-2017 SCHOOL YEAR

On-line registration for the 2016-2017 school year will be available to parents starting on Monday, July 18th through Wednesday, August 24th. Any student who attended **ANY** Coeur d'Alene School District school in 2015-2016 can register on-line. This includes returning to the same school, moving to a new school or moving on to a middle or high school. For those parents who can not access the on-line registration in Skyward Family Access, Ramsey Magnet School of Science will confirm those student registrations on **Thursday, August 18th, from 12:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.** Whether your child was previously at our school or new to Ramsey on an application request, you will still need to come in and verify your student's enrollment information **if you did NOT** go on-line to register them. No child will be actively enrolled until we have the following information: current immunization records and a state certified birth certificate.
