### Dressing Appropriately for ALL weather

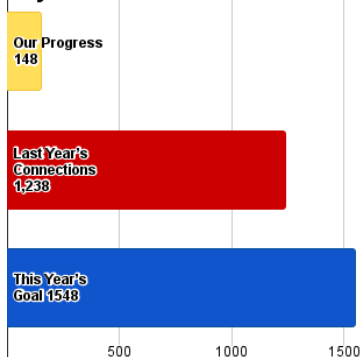

### Bryan Spelling Bees

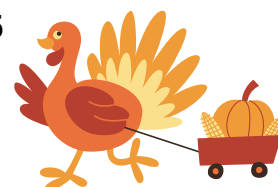
