Paragraph #2 Detail how all of the Senior Project work and study is a reflection of the 3 of the six "C's" of The Portrait of the Graduate. (Please connect the activities perform to three of the six "C's" listed above.

Paragraph #3 Personal statement of *reflection* on learning and growing as an individual within the areas of The Portrait of a Graduate.

Finally, sign the letter with your very best signature and feel accomplished for having provided that last seal of achievement, not only for completing the Senior Project and all it entails, but also for successfully navigating the arduous journey that will culminate on center stage where that diploma signifies YOU are the "portrait of the graduate."
